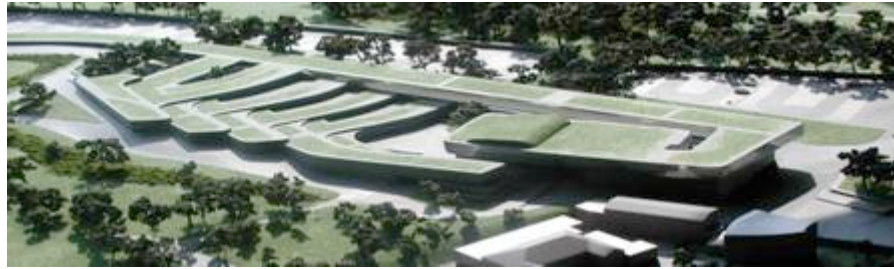

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## I N T R O D U C T I O N

I am a qualified Architect with 15 years post registration experience, during which I have been involved in the completion of projects across a broad range of sectors, both in the UK and abroad.

Immediately upon registration in January 1996, I undertook a period of travel in Australasia, following which I resumed Architecture by taking up a position as Concept Architect for the Lead Consultant on a large scale commercial project in Kuala Lumpur. By working in a small team and overseeing the documentation Architects and Project Engineers; I was able to obtain good team leadership and management skills. The Project demanded a strong liaison between Client and design build turnkey Contractor.

On my return to the UK, I was employed by Devereux Architects in London, where I spent three and a half years developing my all round skills as a Project Architect. I worked successfully with a range of Clients, including the Royal Veterinary College and the Institute of Psychiatry. I was responsible for the delivery of a variety of buildings from concept design through to completion. I also contributed to a number of large healthcare schemes, where I achieved a thorough working knowledge of non traditional procurement routes in large scale publicly funded projects.

In June 2001, I took up a post as Project Architect with B3 Architects in Cardiff. Here I was engaged on a School and Community project, being able to combine the experience of schools design gained during Part 3 training and knowledge of the Private Finance Initiative process.

Subsequently, I was been employed as a Senior Project Architect with Capita Percy Thomas primarily involved in Education sector work as Project Architect, I had a lead role in the successful completion of Phase 1 of the newly formed Combined Universities in Cornwall. I then had a lead role in the production of a Masterplan for the whole site, which formed the basis of delivering the Employer's Requirements and Client Brief prior to tender on phase 2.

I took the opportunity of further developing my Construction Management experience by taking up a post with the Contractor's Architect on a local city centre mixed used development, following which I spent time as a project Architect at the Cardiff Office of Scot Brownrigg, re-utilising my education sector skills, in addition to providing a supporting role to our main Guildford office for a South Wales based Project to house the national tri-service Defence Training Academy
